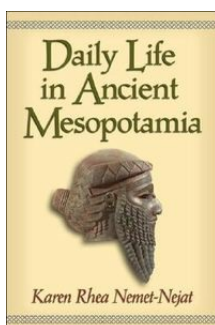


DAILY LIFE IN ANCIENT MESOPOTAMIA
